

# ECSA-C Biennial Conference - Toronto 2018

## Junior Scholar Travel Grant Application

**Purpose:** ECSA-C seeks to support the scholarly development of young researchers. ECSA-C will aim to provide a limited number of **travel grants** to graduate students and early career, junior scholars (post-docs, adjuncts, less than 5 years post-PhD) towards expenses associated with attending the ECSA-C conference at which original research findings are presented.

### **Eligibility:**

- Currently registered graduate students at any University;
- Non-tenure track junior scholars and early career researchers (<5 years post-PhD);
- Traveling from outside the Greater Toronto Area (>75 km- airfare, train or bus);
- Sign in and attend the ECSA-C Youth Research Network (YRN) event/seminar on Wednesday May 9, 2018 (afternoon);
- Membership in good standing, and Conference Registration fees paid to ECSA-C;
- Only one (1) travel grant per person, even if you are presenting on more than one panel;
- \*A limited number of grants may be available for other researchers and faculty from non-OECD nations (please enquire before submitting a form).

**Eligible Expenses:** Transportation and accommodation costs. Other expenses such as food, registration fees, and taxis and public transportation within Toronto will **not** be covered.

**Application:** If you are eligible, please complete all aspects of the form below. Sign and date the form (electronic signature is acceptable) and return via email to [ecsactoronto@gmail.com](mailto:ecsactoronto@gmail.com) by March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018, with the email subject headline 'ECSA-C travel grant application'. Please re-name your completed and saved form: ' \_\_surname, name- ecsa travel grant application 2018\_\_,' before emailing it.

**Amounts:** Travel Grants will be paid out in \$CAD. Amounts will vary by applicant, and will depend on: financial need, distance from Toronto, mode of transportation, etc. Unfortunately, grants will not cover full travel expenses for all applicants, but only a portion thereof.

**Reimbursement:** Payments will be made to successful applicants at the conference, once all conditions are met and documents are verified. Cheques will be disbursed that you can cash at the local bank. Final details on payment methods will be determined at a later date. ***Payments will only be made to applicants who attend the YRN event on May 9<sup>th</sup>.*** If you already have an e-ticket copy, please attach it to your application in the email. If you buy your tickets after the travel grant application deadline, please bring a copy of your transportation ticket to the YRN event sign-in. *Copies of travel receipts must be kept by graduate students for their files.*
